








Specialty Clinics

Mission Bay Multidisciplinary Clinics:

Birthmarks and Vascular Anomalies Clinic (BVAC): Twice monthly

Pediatric dermatology and derm surgery, plastic surgery, diagnostic and interventional radiology, otolaryngology, hematology, ortho. Drs. Frieden, Mathes and Kittler attend.

Pediatric Rheumatology/Dermatology Clinic (RDC): Monthly Peds derm and rheum faculty and fellows, residents. Drs. Cordoro and/or Mathur attend.

cGVHD clinic: Quarterly

BMT, derm, rheum, GI, pulm, oral med, ophtho, PT/OT, etc. Dr. Cordoro or Dr. Mathur attend.







Procedural Clinics

Outpatient Pediatric Laser and Surgery Clinic at MZ

Twice monthly on Wednesday PM and Friday AM at Mt. Zion. Drs. Cordoro and Mathes. Procedures that can be performed in the clinic like simple excisions and lasers. Fellows can also do procedures in their continuity clinics w/ faculty supervision.

OR-Based Ambulatory Surgery Clinic (ASC) at MB OR

Monthly with Dr. Cordoro and Mathes for laser and surgical cases such as complex excisions and nail matrix biopsies for patients who require general anesthesia.

Clinical projects; writing; critical article review; quality projects; patient centered outcomes, global/environmental health/health equity; workforce issues; PeDRA.




