

# UCSF Dermatology Residency – Pediatric Dermatology Focus

UCSF Dermatology is excited to announce a new Pediatric Dermatology Focus (NRMP program code: 1062080A2) within our 3-year dermatology residency program. UCSF Dermatology has one of the top Pediatric Dermatology divisions in the country with a consistent record of training leaders in pediatric dermatology, providing exceptional patient care, and contributing to scholarship in the field. The goal of this track is to support the career development of trainees who are highly committed to pediatric dermatology.

### Track Highlights

- 1. Pediatric Dermatology continuity clinic
- 2. Dedicated mentorship from a pediatric dermatologist
- 3. Participation in mentored pediatric dermatology research and/or quality improvement
- 4. Participation in bi-monthly pediatric dermatology educational conferences
- 5. Opportunity to attend the Society for Pediatric Dermatology and/or Pediatric Dermatology Research Alliance meetings

### Training Structure

The three year residency will include training in general dermatology core areas (medical dermatology, dermatology, dermatologic surgery and pediatric dermatology) to meet Dermatology Residency ACGME requirements and eligibility for primary certification by the American Board of Dermatology.

A separate ACGME accredited pediatric fellowship year is required for subspeciality certification in pediatric dermatology. Trainees who complete this program will be well-qualified to participate in the fellowship match.

### Eligibility

- Demonstrated interest in and commitment to pediatric dermatology.
- Completion of pediatric residency by start of dermatology training preferred but not required.

## Application and Match Process

Anticipated start date for the 2025-26 application cycle is July 2027. Qualified applicants will submit a supplemental essay describing their interest in pediatric dermatology. Applicants will be interviewed alongside traditional clinical dermatology track candidates (Dermatology - 1062080A0) but ranked separately (Derm- Peds Derm Focus - 1062080A2).
